### Ward

2 basic categories = resources & communication strategy
 Building an infrastructure
 Buddy system, not 1 point person
 Know what the needs & resources are - right people in key positions

## Allenspark

- No cmmty or org structure, opp for community project, but mostly elderly. Area Club is taking on efforts but Not much done fire chief mtg to determine needs & in loop, and gathering info to be prepared, and be distributed. Lots of cabin rentals who are new to area which requires basic info distributed into rentals; get info into database for fire dept, distribute into pods / tele charts as to who needs help & what kind; its widely scattered with land & animals; 60% of residents are not occupied at most times; evacuation of animals can be an issue as it gets in way of ER. Community roll off event is a great time to gather family info.
- Individual family evacuation plan; send them out to build data base what's the resistance? = too much Gov't, part timers not enough time

## Gold Hill

- ER should be owned by the community Red cross can come in piece meal; safe site / day info center in GH looking for volunteers, not enough medical volunteers; Red cross run longer term shelters, where communities run Evac sites (minimal services, safe place w/info); from Ned to Lyons how do the sites look?
- People are economically burnt out & maxed out, so they are not available ad they are on front line
- MRC nurses are a resource. Need contacts. 9 health fair is a great resource.
   all volunteers are required to get FEMA 100 & 700 chain of command
   courses (online course)

   response
- Power out = hand radio guide train
- WFAid: not necessary
- Coord w/ward is ongoing

- Neighborlink program: organized to know who can take / care for what (people, animals, etc)
- Evac centers are not clear, comm is not clear btw communities = what does it mean in an ER?; who is more ready; need a Communication site, not far from comty = safe but not far, the holding place.
- Host homes is an adjunct, never enough blankets or food = ask comty to have
- Food: Individual resident preparedness is essential food, water, clothes; this reduces strain on organizers

### Nederland

- Some stuff in database lists need to be better documented
- Neibourhood pods are possible
- Prevention VS response: going to Every home for mitigation to create safe defensible homes. Replace water meters.
- Wild fire prevention plan adopted last night; big proposal in the works
- Local supplies being worked on w/OEM
- Cards for all staff FEMA card is for 1st responders, resident access pass is special paper cards are also possible, faster, cheaper (for the community support network) Marci Lynton
- Electronic communication is primary mode (FB, TW), but it's not for everyone; neighborhood captains are an option = run it thru legal to not assume liability
- Need a better network of communication; 1st few hrs will be chaotic; county & Sheriff were providing different info.
- If there is more technology shared we can share info with OEM feeds are available to public = clear list of command chain & backups, IT could set up a local ER site b4 the crisis = all communities could benefit from this technology.
- Info for homes & people in a fire crisis thru Social Media needs to be monitored.
- What about animal Evac list (incl crates, etc)
- Are there inter Gov't agreemts for Evac No, but can be done in a crisis; hard to commit resources out of county. Comty has a network beyond county lines; shelters in Boulder are not as welcomed; can a formal request to made? Sheriff will be asked 1st in Larimer & Gilpin.
- Restaurants who are willing & able to be on ER list; be clear that it is a donation NOT reimbursed.
- Who takes care of elderly & special needs? Add to ER plan, as the coords need to know early. Contact Pat Critchfie (aging services BoCo)she knows resources to get info ahead of time.
- How to get info on seniors?
- Get info out regarding personal preparedness, along with neighborhood pods.

- In 2003 winter storm, police contacted every person with a snow machine....local intimacy was essential. Info on your system for a local # that is Not 911 = a # that is a resource during an event. How do you set that up? http://www.911dispatch.com/info/311 page.html

- Links with BoCo police are great.
- New template & 2 hour training = Emerg Operations / Community Plan = how to get people out; Coup plan; Emerg Response Plan.
- A major flood would have Lyons on 5 islands.
- A Mtg with fire, police, ER to talk of a plan

- Community member at the EOC Policy group as the rep for their community would be the mayor, or a community liaison. Someone who knows the area during the crisis.
- A Mountain community / Gov't ER doc is needed to detail main tactics, contact lists for designated shelters & people, and Evac & communication info.
